SEASON IN REVIEW

OPERA COLUMBUS is YOURS. Creativity is our culture! Young and the young at heart, opera lovers, and our opera-curious friends all found a place to connect with our most recent season. A season curated with experiences to ensure the art of opera captured the heart of everyone within its reach. Our 22-23 season was innovative and bold, family-friendly, and opera-curious friendly, and above all, it was the grand revival of opera in our vibrant city!

LA CENERENTOLA

A family-friendly production of Rossini's classic comic opera *La Cenerentola* (*Cinderella*), performed in October 2022. This production welcomed our youngest fans & friends to the world of opera by creating engaging pre-performance activities including arts activities, tea parties, story times, and tiara contests.





MARIA DE BUENOS AIRES

Astor Piazzolla's revolutionary nuevo tango opera, performed February 2023. The first Spanish-language opera performed in Columbus, with a strikingly modern production that incorporated dance and high fashion – in collaboration with local Latinx artists – and captions in English and Spanish. *Maria* was OC's highest-grossing production in 10 years.



RIGOLETTO

OC kicked off the spring 2023 season by bringing grand opera back to the Ohio Theatre with Verdi's beloved work, with a sumptuous production in collaboration with our friends at the Columbus Symphony Orchestra and CAPA.



ALICE TIERNEY

Professional world premiere of a new work by composer Melissa Dunphy and librettist Jacqueline Goldfinger, *Alice Tierney* was performed in collaboration with Oberlin Conservatory of Music. Performed on April 29, 2023, in the Riffe Center Studio Theatres. All tickets were offered for free, to make this new women-led work accessible to all. All available tickets were claimed just a few days after the performance was announced.

COOPER-BING COMPETITION

OC's annual vocal competition has celebrated and supported emerging opera artists for nearly 40 years. The 2023 competition was won by mezzo-soprano Gabrielle Beteag, with additional awards won by finalists Ruby Dibble (mezzo-soprano), Kevin Godínez (baritone), Changdai Park (bass-baritone), and Kimberli Render (soprano). Ranking as our largest and most international competition yet; we had 324 applicants, including artists from Australia, Germany, Japan, China, Italy, Mexico, and South Korea. Watch for these rising stars across the stages of opera companies world-wide in the years to come.



COMMUNITY IMPACT

Our community is greater than the sum of its parts, and we are honored to be part of this amazing city. We recognize that it is possible to experience great art in unlikely places like a soccer stadium, a park, bus stops, medical campuses, and your local library. 


FRIENDS OF OPERA COLUMBUS



For the year ended June 30, 2023, the activities from operations resulted in a profit of \$7,713. This excludes activities related to restricted contributions and gain/losses on restricted investments. The unrestricted net assets increased to \$418,281 from \$410,658.

Long-term investments experienced a profit of \$62,192 in FY23 (Operations: \$15,605; Donor Restricted \$46,587). This represents an overall gain of 8% in the Beneficial Interest in assets held by other. The gain was consistent with market activity in 2023 as investement.


