2025 Cooper-Bing Competition

The purpose of The Cooper-Bing Competition is to discover, recognize, and encourage young operatic talent. The Cooper-Bing Competition is an internationally recognized vocal competition that has celebrated and supported emerging young artists in opera. Dubbed "The Olympics of Opera," this competition encourages talent, creates artistic opportunity, and helps welcome the next generation into the professional opera community. Five finalists compete for the grand prize of \$10,000! The 2025 competition will be hosted by WOSU Classical 101's Christopher Purdy as the Master of Ceremonies.

Eligibility

The competition is open to professional and pre-professional singers who have completed, or are engaged in completing a musical education suitable for the operatic stage.

- 1) All applicants must be between 21-35 years of age on May 18, 2025, and <u>available to travel to Columbus</u>, <u>Ohio</u> for the Cooper-Bing Competition Finals (May 18, 2025). *Agenda to begin at 10:30am on May 18, 2025*.
- 2) Past applicants may submit new applications provided they meet the age requirement. Past finalists are not eligible to apply.
- 3) Current full-time employees of the Opera Columbus staff are ineligible to audition.

Application Fee

An application fee of \$25 must be submitted online through YAP Tracker as part of your application. Application fees are non-refundable. If you are unable to submit due to cost, Opera Columbus does have a limited amount of sponsorship opportunities available to cover the \$25 application fee. Application

Each applicant must submit an application form online via YAP Tracker.

Supplemental Materials

Each applicant must submit the following supplemental materials via YAP Tracker:

- a photocopy of their government-issued ID (must show date of birth) or birth certificate
- a photograph (jpeg)
- a current performing resume
- three video files of three different arias (see "Artistic Requirements" below).
- proof of COVID-19 vaccination

Detailed information regarding supplemental materials is included on page three. *All application materials, recordings, and fees become the property of Opera Columbus, and will not be returned to applicants.*



Artistic Requirements

Applicants must submit a high-quality video recording of three-contrasting-arias-from-opera-and/or-operetta. All selections must have accompaniment (piano or orchestra). One recording must be in the English language. You will be disqualified if you do not submit an aria in English. Recordings must be recent (less than one year old) and may include any combination of filmed performances, home recordings, or studio recordings. Video and audio must be clear and unedited.

Applicants may include no more than one aria translated from the original language, and only if it is a piece that is commonly sung in translation.

For guidance on creating high-quality home or rehearsal studio recordings, please review <u>Opera America's</u> Recording Gear Recommendations.

Finals

Five finalists we be selected to attend the Cooper-Bing Competition Finals on May 18, 2025. If selected for the Finals, artists will need to prepare three arias. These arias may be the original submission repertoire selections and/or new selections of repertoire. Each finalist will select their first aria, and the panel will select the second aria prior to the competition date. All finalists will be notified of the judges' aria selection in advance of the competition date.

A panel of opera and voice professionals will judge these recordings and select the five singers who will compete in the live competition.

All applicants will be notified of their status by March 31, 2025.



The Cooper-Bing Competition Finals will be held on **MAY 18, 2025**, at the Southern Theatre in Columbus, OH. A panel of nationally recognized opera professionals will judge those invited to compete in the final round. **Finalists will be responsible for their own transportation to and from Columbus, Ohio and housing for the competition.** Agenda to begin at 10:30am on May 18, 2025.

SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIALS

All supplemental materials are to include the following and should be uploaded via YAP Tracker:

• Copy of government-issued ID or birth certificate

Include a photocopy of <u>either</u> a government-issued ID, such as a driver's license or state ID card (must include date of birth), or your birth certificate. (Required for age verification.)

Photograph

Include a professional headshot (jpeg format).

Performing resume

A performing resume should include complete roles you have prepared, with whom it was performed, awards and grants, musical training and degrees, current and former voice teachers, and any other relevant professional experience. **Maximum two pages.**

Video Recordings

Applicants must submit a high-quality video recording of three-contrasting arias from opera and/or-operetta. All selections must have accompaniment (piano or orchestra). One recording must be in the English language. You will be disqualified if you do not submit an aria in English. Recordings must be recent (less than one year old) and may include any combination of filmed performances, home recordings, or studio recordings. Video and audio must be clear and unedited. Applicants may include no more than one aria translated from the original language, and only if it is a piece that is commonly sung in translation.

- All recordings are reviewed anonymously. Recording files <u>MUST NOT</u> include the applicant's name on the video and/or title of file. Please use the file naming convention: "Aria Title – 2025".
- Audio-only recordings will not be accepted.
- Please do not include additional selections. Applications with more than the three (3) requested arias will not be considered.

Your payment and online application must be completed, and supplemental materials must be uploaded no later than January 15, 2025 by 11:59pm PST.
